

The Guideline for 2024 QE(Qualifying Examination) in the Graduate School of Medicine, Doctoral Program (Medical Science)

1. Target Students

- 3rd years students (entered the school after 2018)
- 2nd years students who wish to participate
- 2nd years students who entered the school in 2022 and are MEXT scholarship (Special Program) students

2. Schedule and Place

Schedule : July 22, Mon., 2024 ~ July 29, Mon., 2024

Place : Science Cafe

3. Method

- (1) Conducted by in-person presentation method using PowerPoint, etc
- (2) Presentation and discussion will be made between 15:00 ~ 17:00 on every weekdays during July 22, Mon. ~ July 29, Mon.
- (3) Each student has 15 minutes (presentation; 6 minutes, discussion; 9 minutes).

4. Evaluation

- (1) Faculty staffs will join the free discussion for searching creative ideas.
- (2) The chairman and one faculty staff will evaluate the research activity of each student.
- (3) Evaluation will be feed back to students at a later date.
- (4) Result of presentations, Educational Committee of Graduate School will select the best research and give a prize.

5. Preferred date of QE

Respond to the Schedule Adjustment (answered from the link in the notification email) by June 7, Fri. .

6. Abstract of QE

- (1) See and fill in the attached sheet 1 "Abstract of QE", and submit until July 8, Mon. to Student Affairs Division.
- (2) Whichever in English or in Japanese is allowed.

7. Result and reflect of QE

See and fill in the attached sheet 3 "Result and reflect of QE", and submit until August 16, Fri. to Student Affairs Division.

8. Improvement measures for the items pointed out

In case of failure, the attached sheet 4 "Improvement measures for the items pointed out" must be submitted by a separately specified date to Student Affairs Division.

9. Absence from QE (only for the 3rd year students)

If the 3rd year student is absent from QE, see and fill in the attached sheet 1 "Report of absence for QE", and submit until June 7, Fri. to Student Affairs Division.
